We have expanded our reach, to provide services to all people, recognizing that this support is also preventative. By coming alongside these individuals and families with appropriate support we want to encourage and equip for a healthier future.

We are looking for an individual to join our team as a *Counselling Team Lead*. Along with the skills of a good leader and psychotherapist, this individual needs to be passionate to help others work through difficult chapters in their lives and have the ability to see potential in all persons.

Job Description:

The Counselling Team Lead regularly engages with counsellors to ensure accountability for the well-being of clients, as well as to provide support through resources and strategies. The Lead will facilitate bi-monthly meetings with the counselling team to review client cases and discuss the direction of therapy and the therapeutic relationship. Team meetings will be structured to promote professional growth. Ideally the lead will bring experience working with vulnerable persons through the trauma lens.

Responsibilities:

- Facilitate bimonthly meetings with counselling team.
- Provide support with client cases as needed.
- Support professional growth of the counselling team.
- Share appropriate resources and strategies with counselling team.
- Reachable by phone/email to consult on cases if needed between bimonthly meetings.
- Ensure clients are receiving appropriate care and counsel.
- Report any concerns or gaps to Program Specialist or Executive Director.

Qualifications:

- Ability to work in a team.
- Strong communication skills.
- Five or more years of extensive clinical experience.
- Member in good standing of a regulatory college whose members practise psychotherapy.
- CBT training is an asset.
- Registered as a clinical supervisor with CRPO is an asset.
